CORONAVIRUS COVID-19 MUNICIPAL MEASURES

March 16, 2020 — The City of Percé wishes to inform its residents that, in accordance with announcements from the Government of Quebec regarding preventive measures aimed at curbing the spread of the coronavirus, it is closing all municipal buildings to the public, such as City hall, libraries and community centres, effective from March 17, until further notice,

We therefore ask you for your cooperation by contacting us only by phone or by email and to avoid going to City hall.
